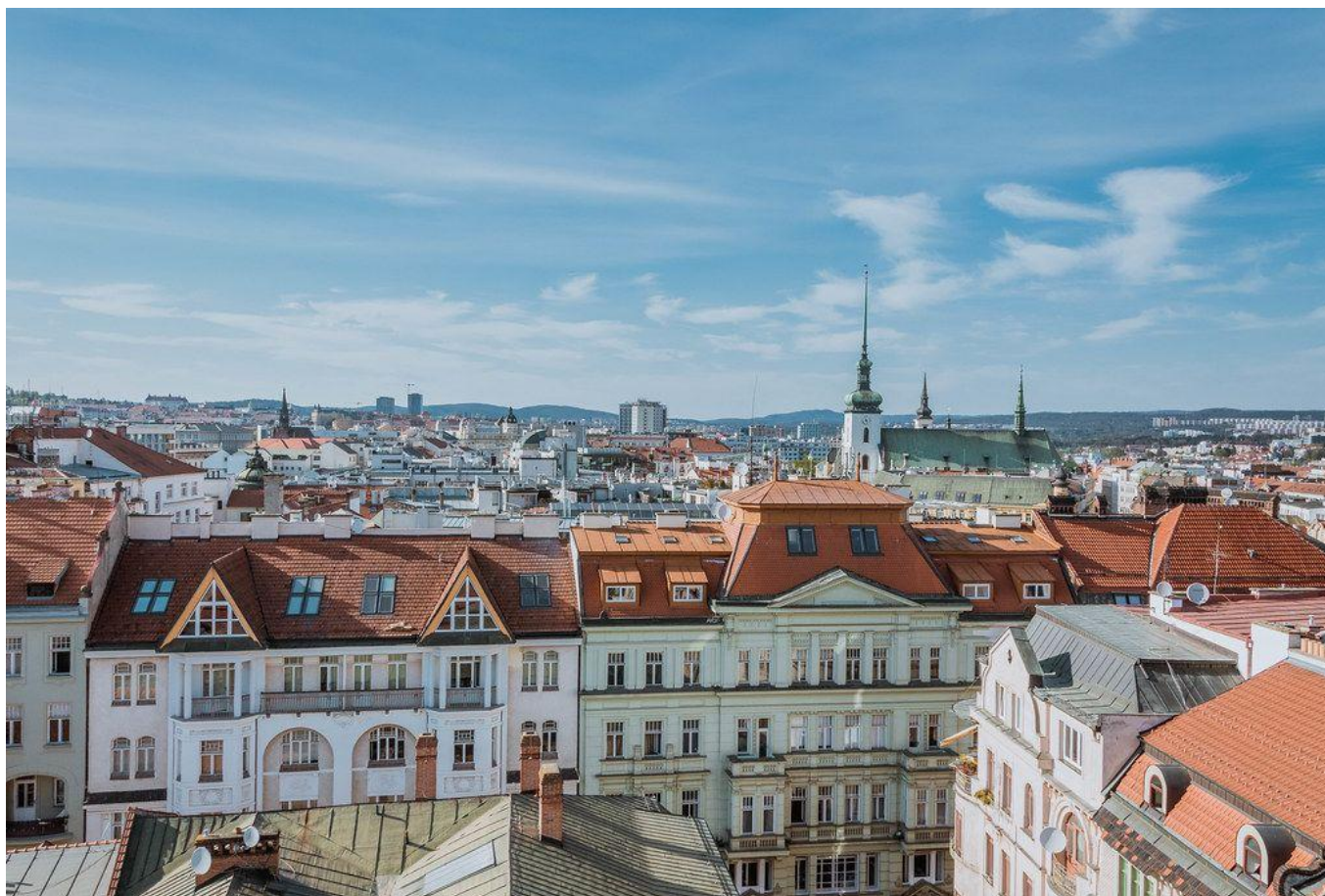
With this first Newsletter of the year, the Erasmus+60 consortium wishes you a **Happy New Year 2023!**

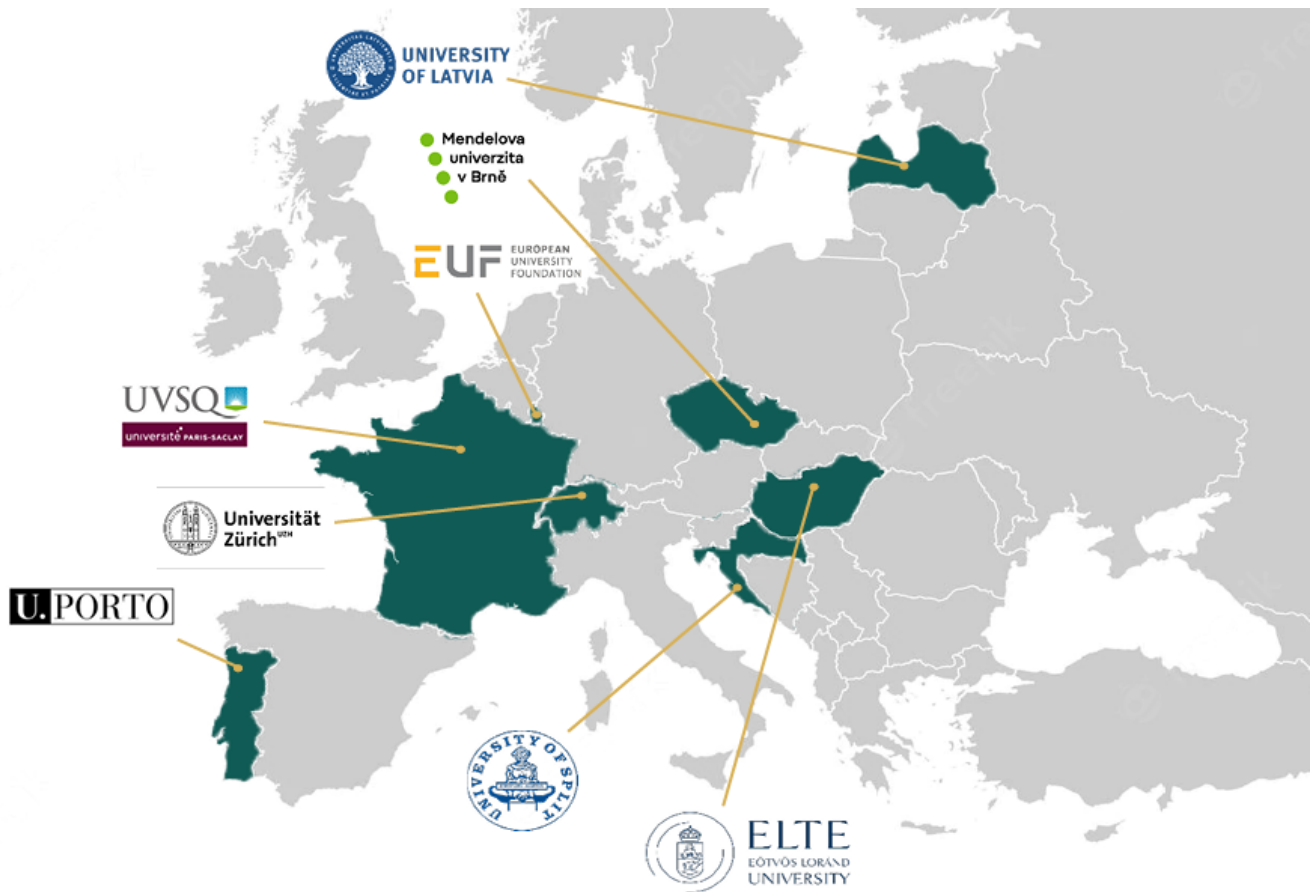
